Tenure-Track/Assistant Professor in U.S. History

The Department of History at Saint Michael's College (Colchester, VT) invites applications for a tenure-track assistant professor in U.S. History - pre-contact to 1865 (Civil War) beginning AY 2022. We welcome applications from all subfields of U.S. history, but preference will be given to candidates whose work focuses on race, gender, and/or public history. Teaching responsibilities will include a general survey in U.S. History - pre-contact to 1865 (Civil War), specialized courses and seminars in the candidate's areas of specialization and interest, and opportunities to advise theses and independent research. Teaching load is six courses per academic year.

Requirements

Applicants should have the following:

- Hold a PhD at the time of appointment
- Ability to demonstrate evidence of an active research agenda
- Evidence of teaching experience and commitment to incorporating a variety of perspectives and preparing students for working in diverse and inclusive environments

An offer of employment will be contingent upon the successful completion of a background check.

Please be prepared to attach all of the following:

- Cover letter
- Curriculum Vitae
- 1-2 page statement summarizing how teaching and research addresses diversity and inclusion, and discussing their interest in cultivating equity and diversity in academic communities.

Applicants are expected to discuss the following:

How have you become more aware of issues of cultural, ethnic, or racial difference as well as social inequity in order to be prepared to work in an institution which is committed to fostering and affirming an inclusive multicultural environment? How will you support and contribute to the mission of the College: "to contribute through higher education to the enhancement of the human person and to the advancement of human culture in the light of the Catholic faith"?

- Names and contact information for 3 references. Reference letters will be requested at a later stage

Review of Applications will begin November 29, 2021 and continue until position is filled.
